Indiana's Hoosier Heroes will be our Special Guests, but our Event is open to the General Public.

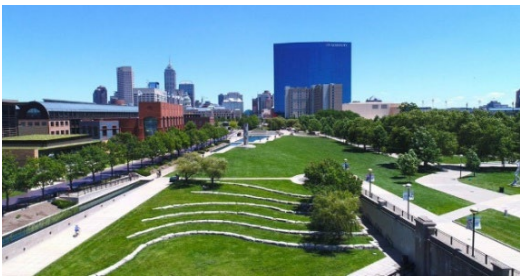
The Hoosier Heroes Program in the TCU Amphitheater with the Indianapolis Municipal Band will be FREE from 10:30 to 12:30 PM.
