What is the Job Center?

The Job Center provides help to unemployed or underemployed individuals through one-on-one personal support at nine Library locations.

Who can use the Job Center?

The Job Center is for anyone looking for a job, looking to change jobs, or simply looking to enhance basic computer and job seeking skills.

What does the Job Center offer?

- Computers and resources: Each Job Center is equipped with computers, internet access, free flash drives, and other job seeking necessities.
- One-on-one attention: Each Job Center is staffed with a Computer Lab Assistant and at select locations a WorkOne staff person who provides further assistance.
- Educational opportunities: In addition to answering job search questions, Job Center Lab Assistants have access to a vast network of job searching resources, as well as tips on how to write a great cover letter and resume.
